**ISRAEL UPDATE - April 19, 2024**

**Congress Advances Vital Aid for Israel Following Iranian Attack**

The House is expected to vote soon on a major bipartisan bill that will fully fund President Biden's \$14.3 billion emergency security assistance request for Israel. Congress must pass this aid to stand with Israel as it confronts attacks from Iran and its proxies, and fights to free the hostages held by Hamas. Call your members of Congress today by visiting [www.callforisrael.org](http://www.callforisrael.org) and urge them to vote yes on this lifesaving security aid for our democratic ally. On Saturday night, Iran carried out a massive and unprecedented attack on Israel. The regime launched over 300 missiles and drones from Iranian soil at Israel, the first time Iran has struck at our ally directly from its own territory. This attack was an act of war by Iran against Israel, and a major escalation of Iran's decades-long campaign of proxy war against the Jewish state. Israel, together with the United States and other allies, successfully intercepted most of the Iranian missiles and drones utilizing the Arrow and David's Sling missile defense systems and American-made F-35 fighter jets. Israel is now considering its response to this Iranian attack.
