From The Rabbi....



I am writing this on the morning after a heart breaking Chiefs loss to the Patriots in the AFC Championship Game. As I said to one congregant today, only half-jokingly - I might need to make myself available for some extensive pastoral counseling this week! It was an incredible game to watch, and a tough loss to swallow. Luckily, Patrick Mahomes and the Chiefs have a bright future ahead of them. As sports fans, we are quite accustomed to the mantra "wait until next year." Anyone who puts their heart and soul into following a team knows that being a fan ends up being more about processing loss than celebrating victory. After all, since the four major sports leagues (MLB, NFL, NBA and NHL) each have around 30 teams, it's likely that the team you root for will usually fall short of winning the championship.

In Judaism, we know that day to day life features more defeat than success. This is why we say the solemn "tachanun" prayer almost every day. It's only on special occasions, such as *Shabbat* and on holidays, that we skip it. *Tachanun* opens with the words of the Book of Samuel, followed by a prayer: "And David said to Gad 'I am exceedingly distressed. Let us fall into the hands of the Lord, for His mercies are abundant'...Oh compassionate and gracious One, I have sinned before You. *Hashem*, who is full of mercy, have mercy on me and accept my supplications." In the daily *tachanun* prayer, we recognize that we are flawed, that we sin, and that we must surrender control to God. Now that the Chiefs' remarkable season is over, perhaps we can find solace in the sense of community and solidarity which is provided by *shul*!

This past *Shabbat*, we celebrated a lovely *Bat Mitzvah* for a fourth generation family at K.I. As for the upcoming calendar, on the educational front, I'll be starting a class in February, Thursday nights at 7 pm, about the *Siddur* - its basic structure and contents. This will pick up from the excellent class on the *siddur* that has been meeting until now under the leadership of **Dan Kass**. My tagline is: now that you've heard the layman's perspective on prayer, come hear the rabbi's perspective! I hope that these two courses will complement each other in that regard. But please note that you don't need to have attended Dan's class in order to follow this one - we'll be starting from scratch.

And on the subject of prayer, let me close with a prayer for the Chiefs: that their next season and beyond be imbued with success and victory!



In July 2016, the Beth Shalom Foundation received a number of contributions to establish the Jacob and Rose Szneler Scholarship Fund. The purpose of the fund is to provide funds to high school students to help underwrite the costs of their participation in an organized trip to Israel and/or Eastern Europe.

Although the funds reside in the Beth Shalom Foundation, all Jewish students in Kansas City and Des Moines, Iowa, are eligible to apply. 2019 applications are due by February 25th and should be emailed to diane.azorsky@yahoo.com.

Applications should include: student's name; grade he/she will be entering in fall 2019; name of Israel and/or Eastern Europe program and sponsoring organization; and a 300-400 word essay explaining why you chose to participate in this trip.

Jacob and Rose Szneler were extraordinary people. Both were born in Poland, spent the war in a number of concentration and work camps and, horrifically, lost their entire immediate families in the Holocaust. After the liberation, Rose and Jacob met in Bergen-Belsen in 1945. They were married in 1946 and immigrated to Des Moines, Iowa in 1950 under the auspices of HIAS. They did not know English, and attended night school in Des Moines to learn English and proudly become United States citizens. Rose worked as a seamstress for a furrier and Jacob worked in a bag factory.

Jacob and Rose each were devoted Jews who benefited their communities with their kindness, hospitality and sense of humor. They cared deeply for the orphan, the widow, the aged and the sick. Jacob and Rose took great pride in the State of Israel and the traditions and history of their people. Jacob died in Des Moines in 1994 and Rose passed away in 2014 in Kansas City (her adopted home).
