From Your Rabbi...



This issue of the *Focal Point* covers two months - June and July. On the Jewish calendar, these months primarily overlap with the Hebrew months of *Sivan* and *Tammuz*. The fact that we run a "two for one" issue of the *Focal Point* for the summer speaks to the fact that the summer is a relatively dormant time for our *shul* life

and programming; as is the reality in most *shuls*. For example, the summer is typically the season in which the rabbi takes vacation!

Becca and Ari and I are heading to California for most of July to spend time with Becca's extended family there. I've also heard that July is a good time to escape the brutal heat of the Kansas City summer. What accounts for the relative dormancy of Jewish communal life in the summer? Is it meant to be the calm before the storm of the High Holiday period in the fall? That might be one aspect to it. I believe there is something else at play as well.

A careful look at the Jewish calendar reveals that all of our biblical holidays are in the spring and the fall. In the spring we have *Pesach* and *Shavuot*. *Purim* comes one month before *Pesach*, serving as a sort of "soft opening" in anticipation of the coming spring season.

In the fall, we have the High Holidays and *Sukkot*. And so, all of our biblical holidays are in the seasons of equinox, the seasons of balance, when nighttime and daytime are roughly equal, and the weather is relatively mild. The summer and the winter, on the other hand, are times of extremes. The summer is too hot and the winter is too cold! This is reflected in the fact that in these two seasons, scripture dictates only fast days - the 10th of *Tevet* in the winter, and the fasts of 17 *Tammuz* and *Tisha B'Av* in the summer. (The winter does have the joyous holiday of *Chanukah*, of course, but *Chanukah* is a post-biblical holiday, which does not qualify as a "yontiff." What it is that accounts for this exception to our seasonal thesis deserves its own treatment; perhaps for another time!)

One lesson we can glean from this is that Judaism values balance and abhors extremes. The spring and fall are fit for joyous celebration and for days of *Yom Tov* because they are times of balance, whereas the summer and the winter are times for introspection and repentance, because there is unbalance in nature. This should not mean we should spend our summer depressed, G-d forbid! Rabbi Nachman of Breslov famously taught, "It is a great *mitzvah* to be joyous, always." I agree with his sentiment.

And so, on that note, I wish us all a joyous summer, but one whose joy is balanced by pause for introspection and reflection.

WHY IS IT CUSTOMARY TO EAT DAIRY ON SHAVUOT?

Shavuot, one of the three pilgrimage festivals, combines two major religious observances. First is the grain harvest of the early summer. Second is the giving of the Torah on Mount Sinai seven weeks after the exodus from Egypt. By associating an ancient holiday of the grain harvest with the exodus from Egypt, Jewish tradition has imbued Shavuot with religious significance derived from the foundational event in Jewish historical consciousness. In the specific case of Shavuot, this takes the form of the entering into a covenant or formal agreement between G-d and Israel at Mount Sinai. This is a joyous time, since it is the moment at which G-d and Israel entered into a figurative marriage with each other, the hopeful springtime of their relationship.

FAST OF TAMMUZ (17TH OF TAMMUZ) SUNDAY, JULY 21

The fast of the 17th of the Hebrew month of *Tammuz*, known as *Shivah Asar B'Tammuz*, is the start of a three week mourning period for the destruction of Jerusalem and the two Holy Temples. Abstaining from food and drink is the external element of a fast day. On a deeper level, a fast day is a day when G-d is accessible, waiting for us to strengthen our relationship. The sages explain: "Every generation for which the Temple is not rebuilt, it is as though the Temple was destroyed for that generation." A fast day is not only a sad day, but an opportune day. It's a day when we are empowered to fix the cause of that destruction, so that we will find ourselves living in messianic times.
