I'm delighted to be writing this installment for the *Focal Point* from the Holy Land.

The rabbis teach us that the very air of the Land of Israel makes one wiser, and that there's no *Torah* like that which emerges from Israel; so I hope that these words might reflect an extra touch of

wisdom!

As I write this, we are about to begin the Book of Exodus, with *Parshat Shmot*. The Land of Israel is mentioned at the most dramatic moment in the *parsha*, when G-d speaks to Moses from the burning bush and assures him that He will liberate the Jewish People and bring them to the land that He promises to the patriarchs. Unfortunately, the people were not aware at the time that they would not reach the Holy Land for forty years after their liberation.

Just for kicks, I tried something that I first saw online a few years ago: I typed my present location into Google Maps, and asked how long it would take to walk from here in Jerusalem to Cairo, Egypt. Amazingly, it only take about seven days! And yet the Jewish people were made to wander for forty years. This only highlights how special it must have been when they finally did enter the Promised Land under the leadership of Joshua, as Moses looked on from Mount Nebo.

The Land of Israel was on our mind a few weeks ago when we co-sponsored a lovely joint study session with BIAV and the KC Kollel on the topic of "Chanukah and Zionism." The chairs in Brown Pavilion were full, and it was so nice to see people from our two local neighborhood shuls come together for Torah study (and donuts)!

But the highlight of the month was surely our *Chanukah* dinner, complete with a rousing musical performance organized by our own **Carolyn Braverman.** The energy in the social hall was palpable, and a meaningful holiday experience was had by all.

Stay tuned for *Purim*, when we're planning a similar dinner event! Looking forward to delivering my full report about my time in Israel on the *Shabbat* after I return. See you in *shul*.




