From Your Rabbi...



I'm happy to share some good news regarding our upcoming *shul* calendar: we've decided to resume both our Friday evening services and our Saturday evening services in-person at K.I. (Please consult the schedule for November in this very edition of the *Focal Point!*) There will no longer be Zoom services

on Friday evening before *Shabbat* begins, as the in-person Friday night service will be our only offering on that front.

Additionally, our *Shabbat* morning services will now begin at 9:30 am (instead of the usual 9 am) as a temporary experiment, at least until the secular new year. A few words about all this! With regards to Friday evenings, we were content to keep that service on Zoom for the past few months. But as the clock will now "fall back," and *Shabbat* starts to come in so early - and since any Zoom service has to be completed before *Shabbat* begins - it seems like the right time to return to in-person services. As is the case with all of our services during this pandemic, they will take place in the sanctuary, and masks and distancing will be required.

As for *Shabbat* morning, we've followed the advice of various national synagogue organizations to shorten the service during the pandemic. As such, we've been finishing consistently each week at around 10:45 am. Many people still prefer to come to *shul* late, and they have found that when they arrive, the service is basically already close to ending. So, it was recommended that we begin later. And that's fine with me! I say, "If you can't beat 'em, join 'em." So we'll change the **start time to 9:30 am** for the time being, and we'll likely finish each week now at around 11:15 am, closer to when people are used to ending.

Finally, with regards to *Shabbat* afternoon services: sadly, we cannot have the customary *shaleshudos* (*seudah shlishit*) meal between *Mincha* and *Maariv* during the pandemic. So, instead of *shaleshudos*, I'll be teaching my weekly *parsha* class during that time slot. (This is the class which would usually take place BEFORE *Mincha*; for now it will simply be shifted to AFTER *Mincha*, in lieu of *shaleshudos*). Instead of nourishing our stomachs, we'll nourish our souls and our intellects! It's becoming cliché to say at this point, but these are unprecedented times that we are living in.

We at K.I. are doing our best to roll with the punches and maintain our communal life as best as we can. I'm pleased to be able to say that I think that we've been doing so quite well
