From Your Rabbi... From Your President...



On the last day of *Pesach*, before *Yizkor*, I spoke in tribute to the rabbi emeritus of my childhood *shul*, Rabbi Arnold Feldman, of blessed memory, who passed away a few months ago. I am condensing part of those remarks into this article.

Growing up, my main rabbinic role model was obviously my father. But Rabbi Feldman was really the first "independent" model that

I had for what a rabbi should be; by which I mean, my father has always been primarily my father to me, and a rabbi secondarily. But from a young age I looked to Rabbi Feldman as a sort of abstract model of, "I guess that's what a rabbi is!"

Rabbi Feldman was a young emeritus when we arrived at Shaare Shamayim in Northeast Philadelphia, a Traditional *shul* quite similar to K.I. He had recently retired as a rabbi in his early 50's to pursue a career as a trial lawyer, defending people who had been wrongfully terminated. (I didn't think he was a young emeritus when I was a kid, but now I realize that he was!) He was gracious enough to take my father under his wing and would go on to become my father's primary rabbinic mentor and role model, even after we left Philadelphia.

It didn't surprise anyone that Rabbi Feldman went on to become a successful trial lawyer. He looked and spoke like a movie star, with great dignity and conviction, and with wit and warmth. You could easily picture him convincing any jury. He exuded a strong, paternal presence in the way that only the great old time rabbis did, and he commanded great authority. Even as a young kid, when I would hear him speak, I knew that he was speaking with a sense of considerable authority, even before I could understand the content of what he was saying.

I would only hear him speak a few times a year, primarily on the High Holidays. On the second day of *Rosh Hashanah*, he officiated in the main sanctuary, while my father switched to preside over the overflow service. But even those few times that I would hear him in action left a great impression. Years later, in my early 20's, I returned to Shaare Shamayim for two years as the High Holiday *chazzan* for *Shacharit*, and as the *shofar* blower, and I was blessed to be able to officiate with Rabbi Feldman at the overflow service, and to see him in action once again. He still had the same gravitas that I'd remembered him for as a child.

Rabbi Feldman had studied at Yeshiva University under the great Rabbi Joseph B. Soloveitchik, who would later send him to Philadelphia. He really embodied for me the essence of Modern Orthodoxy, before I even knew what that term meant. He was worldly and sophisticated, while also remaining staunchly traditional. I remember once he told me that as a trial lawyer he couldn't openly wear a *yamaka*, so as not to potentially bias the jury. So he brought me close, and showed me something neat: he

We finished the month of April with the main focus of Passover, a Biblical event which represents the redemption of our people from slavery from Egypt so many years ago. In May (*Iyar* in the Hebrew calendar) we have at least four modern day commemorations: two sad ones—*Yom HaShoah* and *Yom HaZikaron*—followed by two happy occasions: *Yom HaAtzmaut*,

which is an event that took place that we as the Jewish people had been waiting and praying for, for many centuries, i.e. the birth of the Modern Day State of Israel and in addition, *Yom Yerushalayim*, the day commemorating the unification of Jerusalem.

In the local commemoration of *Yom HaZikaron*, K.I. was well represented in the very solemn and meaningful ceremony at The J. **Rabbi Grussgott's** meaningful recitation of the *Yizkor* prayer, followed by the beautiful voice of **Cantor Hayoun** accompanied by Jeannie Frank at the keyboard, as well as a mournful *El Malei Rahamim*. The following day, *Yom HaAtzmaut*, Cantor Hayoun treated the morning *minyannaires* with a musical *Hallel* accompanying himself on the guitar. A first for K.I. and one enjoyed by all. Cantor Hayoun keeps me amazed with everything that he would like to do to make K.I. services more enjoyable.

Now that I am officially embedded at the helm, I really appreciate what Moses must have gone through trying to lead the Jewish people. Not implying that I am, or my position, is anything remotely close to that magnitude. However, just like Moses had Aaron and Joshua, I am fortunate to have very capable members of the Executive Board to stand by me and provide assistance and advice. I am trying to get to know "the lay of the land" and to see how we can improve and maintain the building and other structures of K.I.

I have received good suggestions from fellow congregants and will work toward trying to incorporate them. As always, I encourage people to get involved in the many different activities available like classes, *kiddush* preparations, choir groups, and many more.

As with everything, COVID did a number on all of us, but we are trying to get back to participating in person and once again becoming a *KEHILLAH* (a community).

On that note, on June 3, 2022, Cantor Hayoun has prepared a musical program to bring in *Shabbat*. The musical program will end as *Shabbat* begins and following our normal beautiful Friday evening services, a delicious *Shabbat* dinner will be available for a price, prepared by our WoKIs.

Our next "chag" holiday of *Shavuot* is coming up. Please plan to attend services and share in the celebration of receiving the *Torah* on Mount Sinai.

WHY IS IT CUSTOMARY TO EAT DAIRY ON SHAVUOT?

It has become customary on *Shavuot* to eat at least one dairy meal during the holiday. Some see this as symbolizing "a land flowing with milk and honey." Others point out that the very same verses that speak of bringing "the choicest first fruits of the land unto the house of the Lord your G-d" in celebration of *Shavuot* also stress that "You must not boil a kid in its mother's milk." (Ex. 23:19, 34:26.) On the basis of the latter part of these verses, the Oral *Torah* based its prohibition of eating meat and milk together. Hence, a separate dairy meal is deliberately eaten to emphasize the authenticity of the Oral *Torah*.

had a *yamaka* fastened underneath his toupee! That was his clever solution.

I wanted to share my memories of him with all of you, since, while my eventual career path as the rabbi of a Traditional *shul* has obviously been primarily influenced by my father, it has also been influenced to a significant extent by my early memories and impressions of Rabbi Feldman, and by the early influence that he had in my life. The Talmud captures the traditional ethos of "*Yeridat HaDorot*," the decline of the generations: *Shabbat* 112b - "Rabbi Zeira said in the name of Rava bar Zimuna: If the early generations are characterized as sons of angels, we are the sons of men." With no offense intended toward my generation of rabbis, and while it might be cliché to say, the memory of Rabbi Feldman reminds us that "they don't make them like they used to." May his memory be for a blessing.

On Tuesday, August 2nd, there will be a vote on the Kansas ballot about amending the Kansas Constitution. Anyone who is a registered voter in Kansas can vote on this proposal. Normally in a primary election you have to vote either a Democratic slate or the Republican slate, and that is true on this election too; however, for the amendment question, anyone even if you are an Independent can vote.

From a Jewish point of view, this is a very important vote. A YES vote would make it extremely difficult for someone to obtain an abortion in the state of Kansas, regardless of the medical need or necessity of such a procedure. This would be especially true if the Roe vs Wade decision that the Supreme Court will deliver in June will eliminate the national protection for abortion.

A YES vote would actually put the prohibition of abortion into the Kansas Constitution and make it very difficult for individuals seeking such medical help. A NO vote would not guarantee the right to abortion but would make it very difficult for opponents to abortion to make abortion illegal in Kansas.

Jewish law has a whole variety of views on the topic of abortion. Abortion "on demand" such as "I do not feel like having this child" is definitely against Jewish law, though not considered murder. However, an abortion after rape, incest or with serious medical issues to the mother and/or fetus is permitted. There are also medical circumstances when abortion is mandated or demanded in Jewish law, such as when the mother's life is in danger.

I can unequivocally state that from a Jewish legal point of view, it is absolutely necessary for anyone who is a voter in the state of Kansas, which is most of our membership, to vote NO on the amendment dealing with abortion rights.

FAST OF TAMMUZ (17TH OF TAMMUZ) SUNDAY, JULY 17

The fast of the 17th of the Hebrew month of *Tammuz*, known as *Shivah Asar B'Tammuz*, is the start of a three week mourning period for the destruction of Jerusalem and the two Holy Temples. Abstaining from food and drink is the external element of a fast day. On a deeper level, a fast day is a day when G-d is accessible, waiting for us to strengthen our relationship. The sages explain: "Every generation for which the Temple is not rebuilt, it is as though the Temple was destroyed for that generation." A fast day is not only a sad day, but an opportune day. It's a day when we are empowered to fix the cause of that destruction, so that we will find ourselves living in messianic times.
