From Your Rabbi...



I always enjoy teaching the Women's Class at *shul*. Rabbi Mandl and I have been co-teaching it for the past few years, on an alternating basis. The format of the class is informal Q and A, and so it keeps me on my toes! I always wonder if there will be enough to discuss, and without fail, there indeed always is. Sometimes

the questions are plain and pragmatic, such as how to prepare for *Pesach*.

While teaching the class a few weeks ago, as *Pesach* was approaching, I was expecting to field questions like that. But out of the blue, someone asked me: when will the *Mashiach* come? That's quite a question! I went through the painful history of false Messiahs, such as the infamous Shabtai Tzvi in the 17th century, and opined about how dangerous it can be to try and predict when the Messiah will arrive. The traditional stance is that we will wait for G-d to bring it about in its proper time. However, there is one tradition, based in the *Talmud*, that the *Mashiach* has to arrive by the year 6000. This is based on the notion that a millennium is like one day to G-d. The first six millennia of history are like the 6 regular days of the week, and the 7th millennium will be the Messianic Age, the Sabbath of history.

We are currently holding in the year 5783. That's pretty close to the year 6000! Only 217 years away, to be exact. That means that a baby born today who lives to be 105 could live to see the birth of a descendant who, in turn, lives to be 112 and is guaranteed to witness the messianic age! Of course, we always pray for the *Mashiach* to come before this "deadline". But all of this speculation goes to show that it's our task to just humbly do our best here on earth and let G-d sort out the details.

In May, we have *Shavuot* coming up, at the end of the month. I'm pleased to announce that we are reviving a late night *Shavuot* program at K.I. on Thursday night, May 25th. While we won't go all night, we will have *Mincha/Maariv* services at 8:20 pm, followed by dinner at 9:15 pm; Bill Greenberg will speak at 10:00 pm about his experience being stationed in the Sinai Desert with the US Army. It should be a wonderful program! I hope to see you there.

Wishing us a happy *Shavuot* in advance.



WHY IS IT CUSTOMARY TO EAT DAIRY ON SHAVUOT?

•••••

It has become customary on *Shavuot* to eat at least one dairy meal during the holiday. Some see this as symbolizing "a land flowing with milk and honey." Others point out that the very same verses that speak of bringing "the choicest first fruits of the land unto the house of the Lord your G-d" in celebration of *Shavuot* also stress that "You must not boil a kid in its mother's milk." (Ex. 23:19, 34:26.) On the basis of the latter part of these verses, the Oral *Torah* based its prohibition of eating meat and milk together. Hence, a separate dairy meal is deliberately eaten to emphasize the authenticity of the Oral *Torah*.
