## From Your Rabbi... From The President...



We as Jews are living through surreal times. I felt like I had to pinch myself while watching the shameful testimony of three Ivy League University presidents, to see if it was truly real. A congresswoman asked all three of them – presidents of Harvard, MIT, and University of Pennsylvania – if calling for the genocide of Jews constitutes a violation of their institution's code of conduct. All three gave equivocal answers, saying that it would depend on the context. It's hard to imagine that calling for the genocide of any other minority group would be met with such prevarication. It seems that the world's oldest hatred still plagues us all too much.

Over *Chanukah*, I was reading Bibi Netanyahu's excellent book about Israel called, "A Place Among the Nations." In it, he quotes a passage from the "Book of Maccabees," about which he jokes, could have been plucked from recent headlines. Judah Maccabee had died in battle and his brother Simon was appointed High Priest and ruler of Judea. Greek King Antiochus wrote Simon the Hasmonean an angry message accusing him of occupying foreign land! (Sound familiar?):

1 Maccabees 15: 28 – 31:

"You are occupying Joppa (modern day Tel Aviv-Yafo) and Gazara and the citadel of Jerusalem; these are cities of my kingdom. You have laid waste their territories, done great harm to the land, and taken possession of many districts in my kingdom. Now, therefore, give up the cities you have seized and the tribute money of the districts you control outside the territory of Judea; or instead, pay me five hundred talents of silver for the devastation you have caused and five hundred talents more for the tribute money of the cities. If you do not do this, we will come and make war on you." Simon's response resonates through the ages – (verses 33-34): Simon said to him in reply: "It is not foreign land that we have taken nor have we seized the property of others, but only our ancestral heritage which for a time had been unjustly held by our enemies. Now that we have the opportunity, we are holding on to the heritage of our ancestors."

We are now beginning to read the Book of Exodus. Rashi comments on the first chapter of Exodus, that just as Pharaoh feared that the Jewish People would increase, G-d responded to him, "Ken yirbu," so too, they will increase!

Our modern-day Maccabees in the IDF are ensuring that life in the modern State of Israel will only flourish and endure in the face of the evil that tried to stymie it. Let us continue to pray to G-d to grant them success in achieving this result.

Solomon.

## GUARDIAN SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATIONS

FIRST TIME CAMPERS INCENTIVE GRANTS – The Guardian Society provides "incentive grants" to children attending Jewish overnight camp for the first time on a first-come first-served basis. These grants will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, to children the first time they attend Jewish overnight camp for three weeks or longer and have not previously received a first-time camper grant. In order to qualify for the incentive grant, children must live in the Greater Kansas City area and attend an approved Jewish camp program.

Families who need assistance sending children to camp for fewer than three weeks are encouraged to apply for financial assistance from their congregations and from The Guardian Society.
