From Your Rabbi...



The Mishnaic Rabbis instruct us: "When the month of *Adar* begins, we increase our joy." What is it about *Adar* that makes it so joyous? Rashi explains that the onset of *Adar* begins the celebration of two springtime holidays of liberation: First *Purim*, and then, one month later, *Pesach*. Both of these holidays encapsulate the classic Jewish sentiment of, "They tried to kill us, we won, let's eat!"

On *Purim*, it was the ancient Persians who tried to kill us; on *Pesach*, it was the Egyptians, centuries earlier. These two holidays also usher in the springtime, when the weather gets better and things begin to bloom again. All of this is good reason to increase our joy in *Adar*.

According to Rashi's interpretation, the joy that begins in *Adar* culminates in *Pesach*. But later, the *Hasidic* tradition taught the increased joy should extend all the way to *Shavuot*, 7 weeks after *Pesach*. This date, on which we received the *Torah*, constitutes the highest level of joy.

This year is a Jewish leap year, in which we have two months of *Adar*. *Purim* is observed in the Second *Adar*, in order that it should fall one month before *Pesach*. But we begin to increase our joy already with the First *Adar*.

The Rabbinic Sages figured out that in order to sync up the lunar and solar cycles, we need to have seven leap years every 19 years. We can certainly use some increased joy this year. Four months have passed since the *Simchat Torah* massacre of October 7th in Israel. We have reasons to be joyous, even in our continued grief. Israeli society has proven remarkably resilient, hopeful, and strong in the face of tragedy.

We in the diaspora must continue to show solidarity with them by continuing to be proudly Jewish, and joyously Jewish. Let's commit to being Jewish more joyously as *Adar* begins!
