ISRAEL UPDATE - May 3, 2024

Israel awaits response to “extraordinarily generous” proposal as it prepares for Rafah operation

On Monday, Secretary of State Antony Blinken urged Hamas to accept a deal to pause the fighting in Gaza and surge aid into Gaza in exchange for the release of hostages. Blinken said, “Hamas has before it a proposal that is extraordinarily, extraordinarily generous on the part of Israel and in this moment the only thing standing between the people of Gaza and a ceasefire is Hamas.” President Joe Biden added, “The release of hostages held by Hamas is now the only obstacle to an immediate ceasefire and relief for civilians in Gaza.” Once again, Hamas, not Israel, is preventing a temporary pause in fighting and surge in humanitarian aid to Gazan civilians. Meanwhile, Israel is advancing final plans for an operation in Rafah to drive Hamas from power and destroy its remaining terrorist battalions. As Israeli War Cabinet Minister Benny Gantz said, “Finishing the war without demilitarizing Rafah is like sending in firefighters to put out 80% of a fire.” The United States must continue to stand with Israel and ensure our ally has the time, space and resources needed to defeat Hamas and protect its families.
