ISRAEL UPDATE - May 17, 2024

Amidst Ongoing War, Israel Marks Memorial, Independence Days

Israeli Memorial Day began Sunday evening, as the country commemorated the deadliest year in five decades, with 1,600 soldiers and civilians killed in war and terror. Speaking at a state ceremony at the Western Wall, Israeli President Isaac Herzog said: "All we wanted was to return to Zion, from which we were forcibly expelled, and to renew our freedom there — in a Jewish and democratic state. To build a life here. A future. A hope. We always dreamed of peace and good neighborliness with all the peoples and countries in the region, and forever, no less. But so long as our enemies seek to destroy us, we will not lay down our swords." Beginning Monday night, Israel marked its 76th Independence Day. Addressing the state ceremony was Israeli Knesset Speaker Amir Ohana, who offered a message to the 132 hostages still being held in Gaza: "All Israelis await your return. All synagogues in Israel and in the Diaspora are praying for your well-being. We will not despair and we will not give up. Do not lose hope." For 76 years, the United States has proudly supported Israel, and we must continue to stand with the Jewish state as our ally works to defend itself.
